Beyoncé Announced as NAACP *Entertainer of the Year*

LOS ANGELES (March 30, 2019) – The winners of the 50th NAACP Image Awards were announced tonight during the live broadcast on TV One from The Dolby Theatre in Hollywood. The live special was hosted by Anthony Anderson, who also doubled as nominee, and took home the award for Outstanding Actor in a Comedy Series for his role on *black-ish*. **Beyoncé** was honored as the NAACP *Entertainer of the Year*, and Congresswoman **Maxine Waters** was presented the NAACP *Chairman's Award*. Additional winners included radio host and personality **Tom Joyner** who was presented with the Vanguard Award, which recognizes an individual whose groundbreaking work increases our understanding and awareness of racial and social issues and **NE-YO**, who was awarded the inaugural Black & Positively Golden Music Honor Sponsored by McDonald's, and **Shawn "JAY-Z" Carter** who NAACP President **Derrick Johnson** presented with the prestigious President's Award.
